Randy Starks' charges reduced to traffic offense

Miami Dolphins defensive lineman Randy Starks' court case was resolved favorably today.

Starks' case was reduced to a traffic offense, adjudicated down from a previous misdemeanor charge of culpable negligence, according to the South Florida Sun-Sentinel.

Now, the former Tennessee Titans and University of Maryland player will only have to pay a \$219 fine and attend eight hours of traffic school.

Starks was initially facing a felony aggravated assault case that was subsequently dropped.
